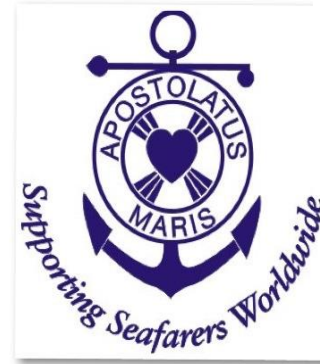
*Kitchen Porter's General Duties are:-*

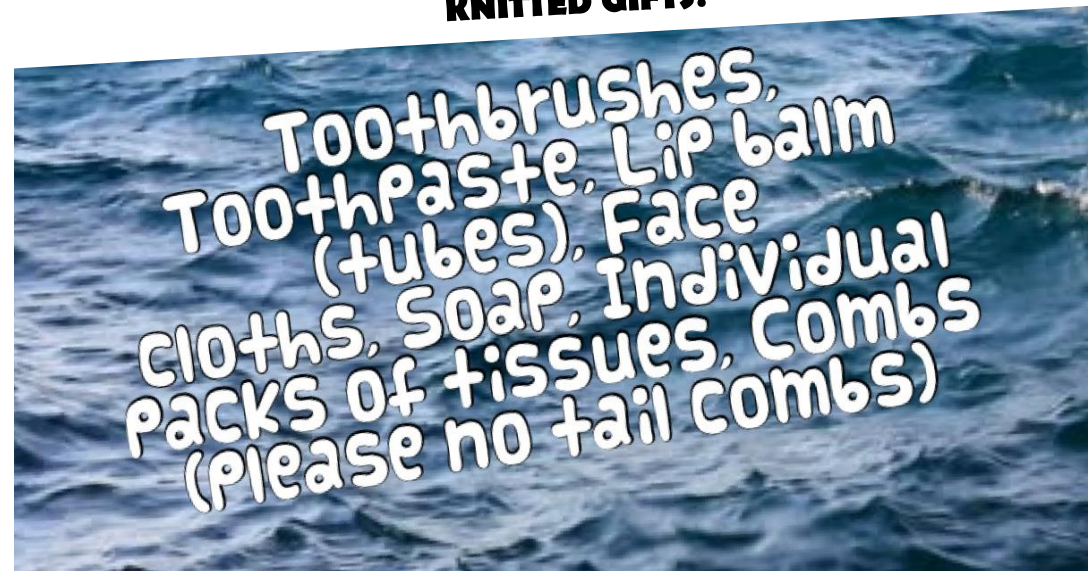
